EOCIL Receives Grant from M.A.C AIDS Fund

Eastern Oregon Center for Independent Living (EOCIL) announced on Monday, November 15, 2010, that the agency received an award of \$20,000 from the M.A.C AIDS Fund for the ‘Second Chance Housing Program’ for people living with HIV/AIDS in rural Oregon.

EOCIL provides independent living services in 13 counties within eastern and central Oregon. The Center has three offices located in Ontario, Pendleton and The Dalles. “This grant money will make it possible for EOCIL’s clients that are either homeless or in danger of losing their homes and those that are on long term wait lists for housing to secure a place to live and to get back on their feet, to take care of their health” says Heidi Eidler, Director of Programs & Services.
